Responsibilities

- Communicate issues with vessels to Program or Operational Director
- Oversee end of day procedures
- Ensure boats, equipment, and supplies are properly stored and secured
- Provide feedback to participants about aspects of their performance
- Complete skill acquisition sheet for each sailor by the end of the week and file in designated folder in CSC Google Drive
- Monitor Junior Instructor performance and safety while on the water
- Communicates with and reports to Program Director in order to provide sailing instruction in a fun and safe environment
